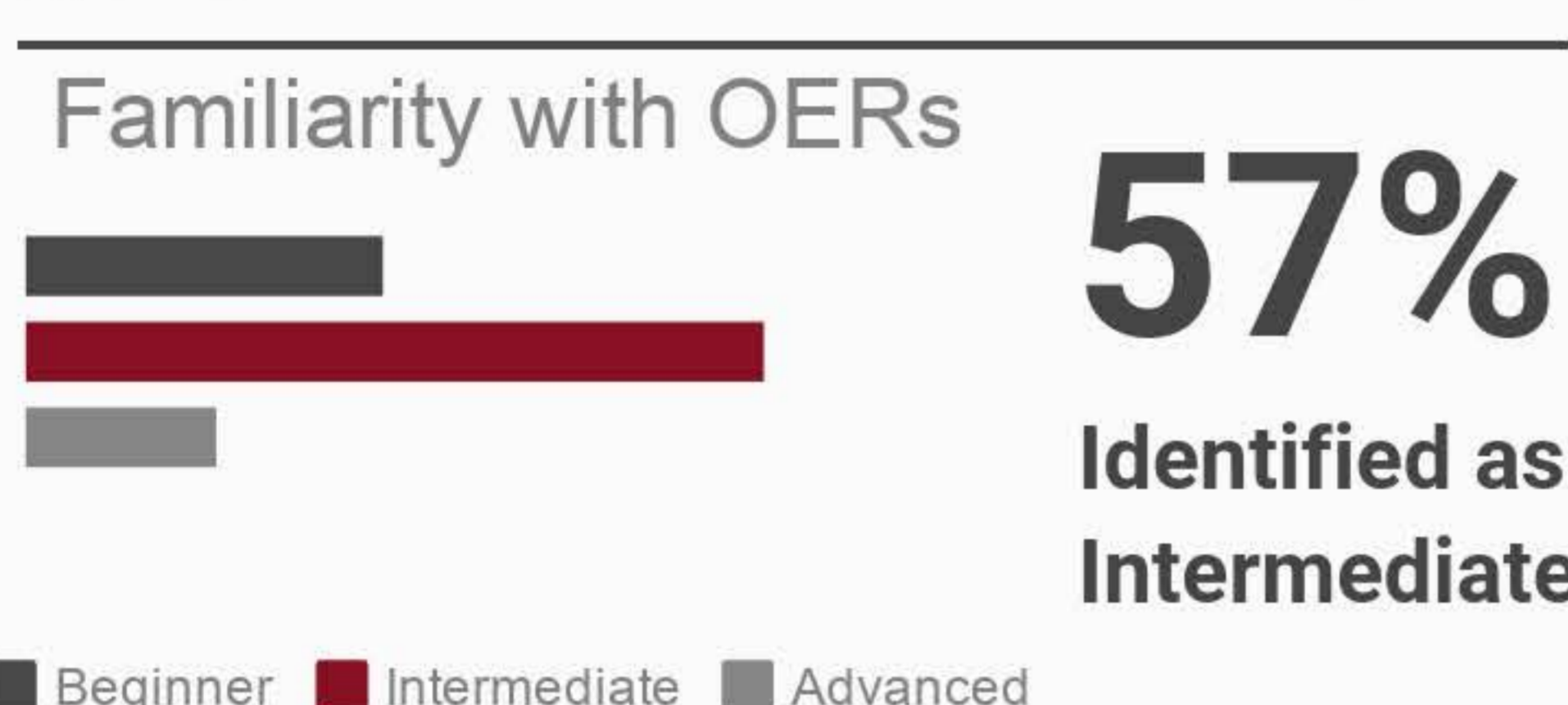

- **Advanced: 1-7 Repositories**

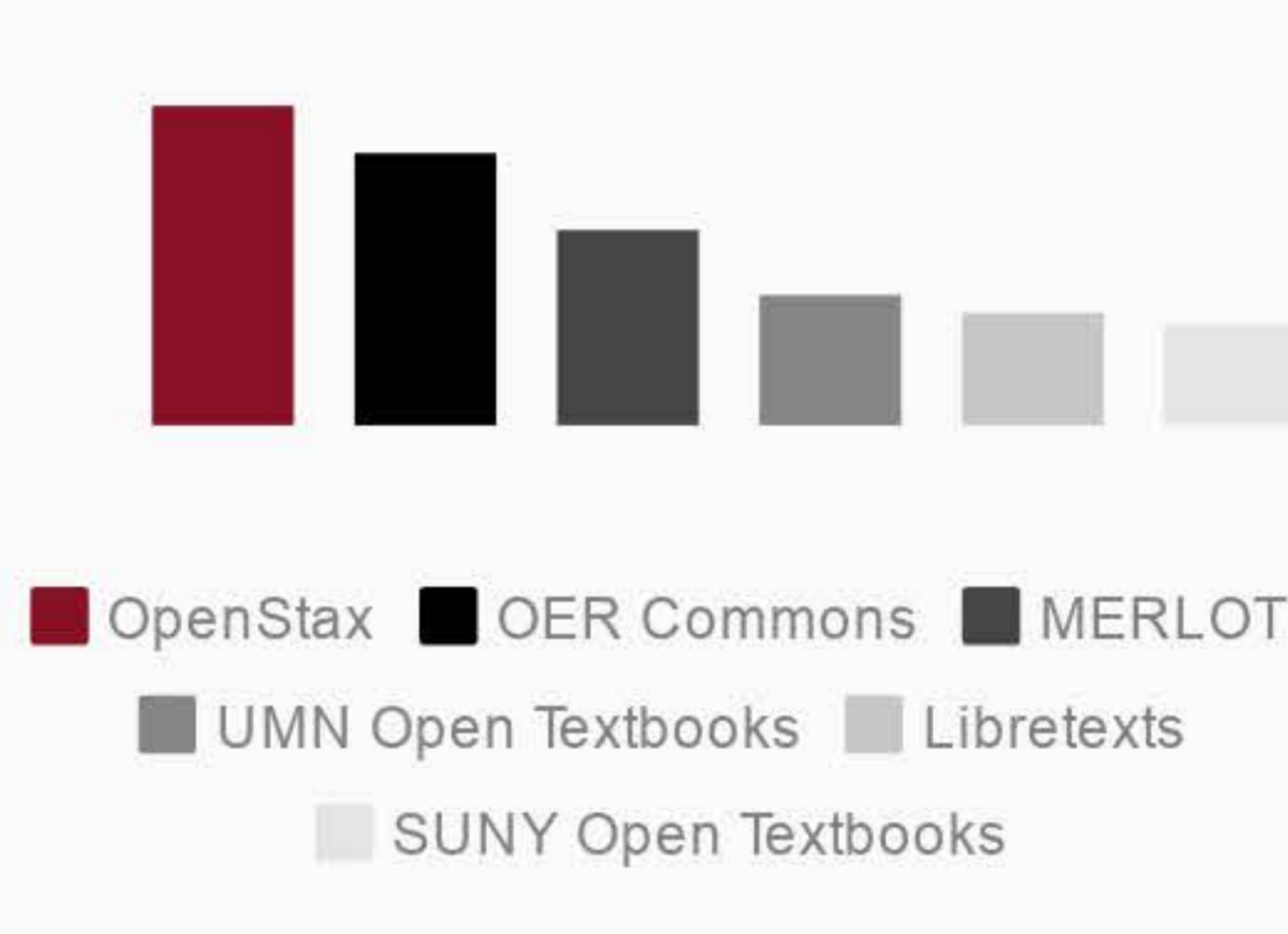
You probably know more than you think you do!

★ **OpenStax and OER Commons were the most familiar OER Repositories**

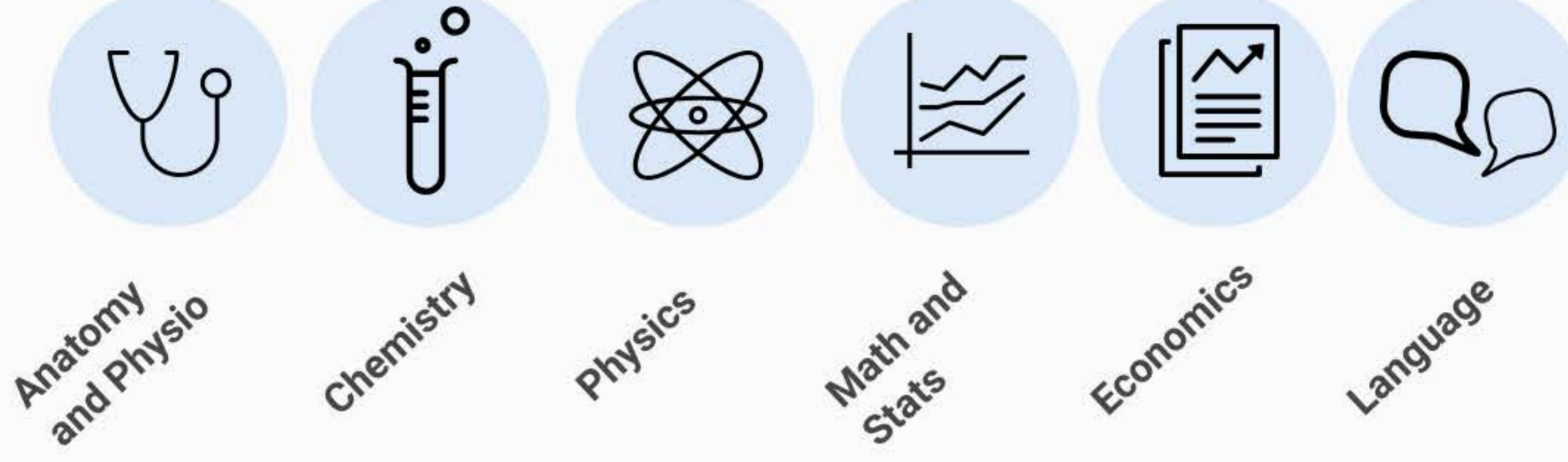
Other REpositories mentioned were: MIT Open Courseware, COERLL, QUBES, Skill Commons, OAPEN and more

Null Responses: 20%

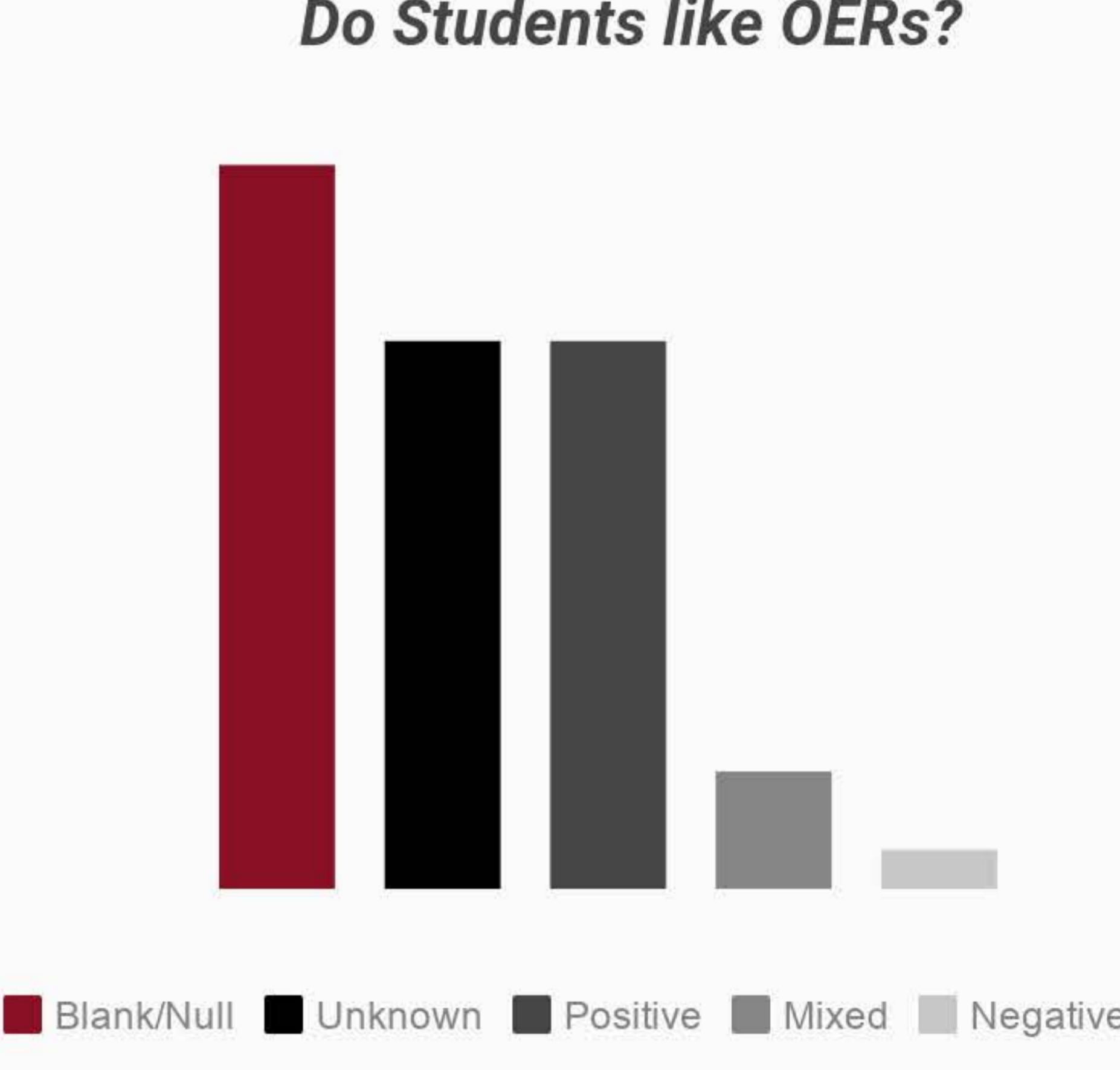
48% Respondents currently use or are planning to use OERs

7% Indicated that they used OERs, but the resources indicated were not OERs

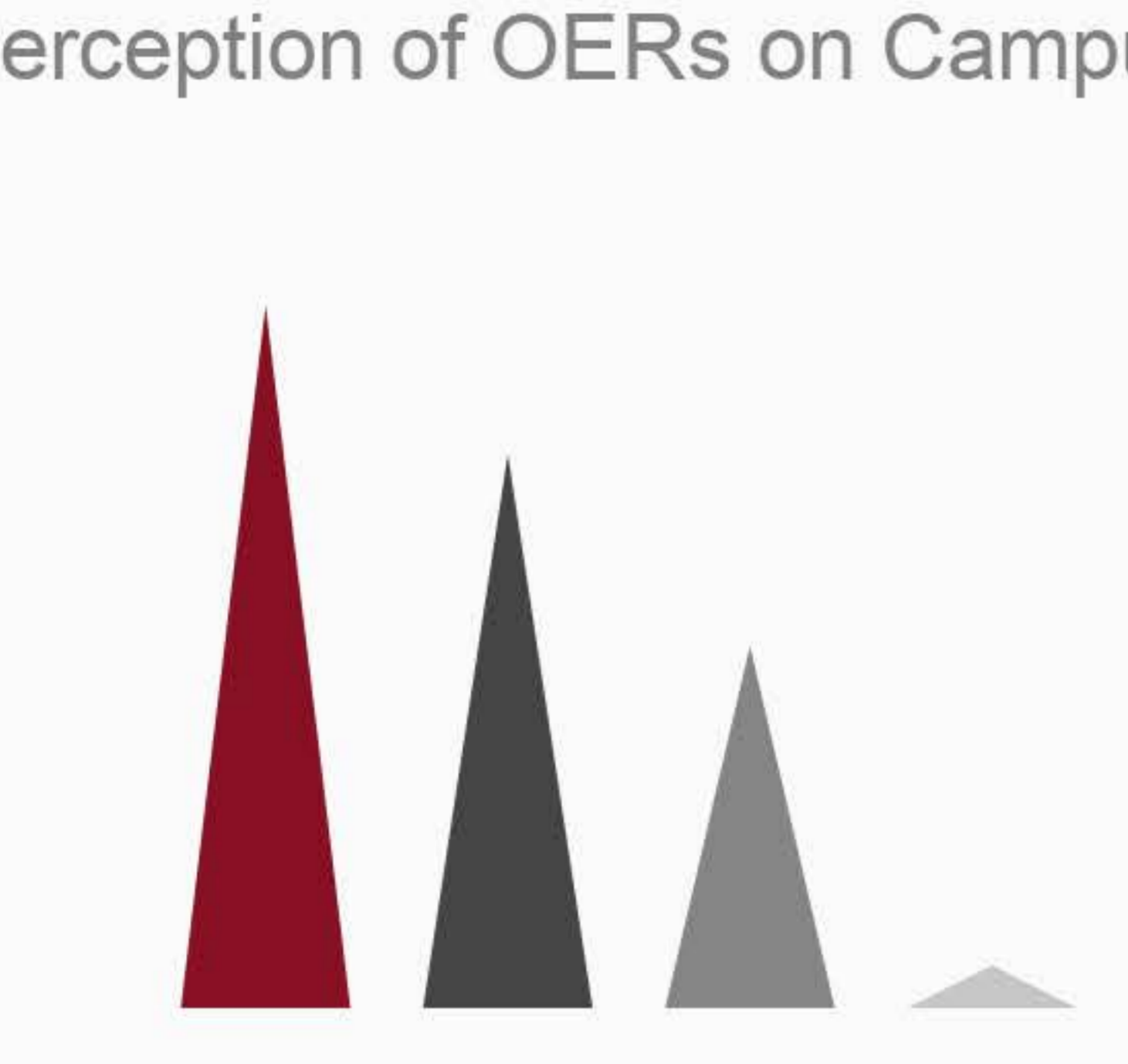
“How does your institution define OER? What qualifies as OER?”

Null Responses: 43%

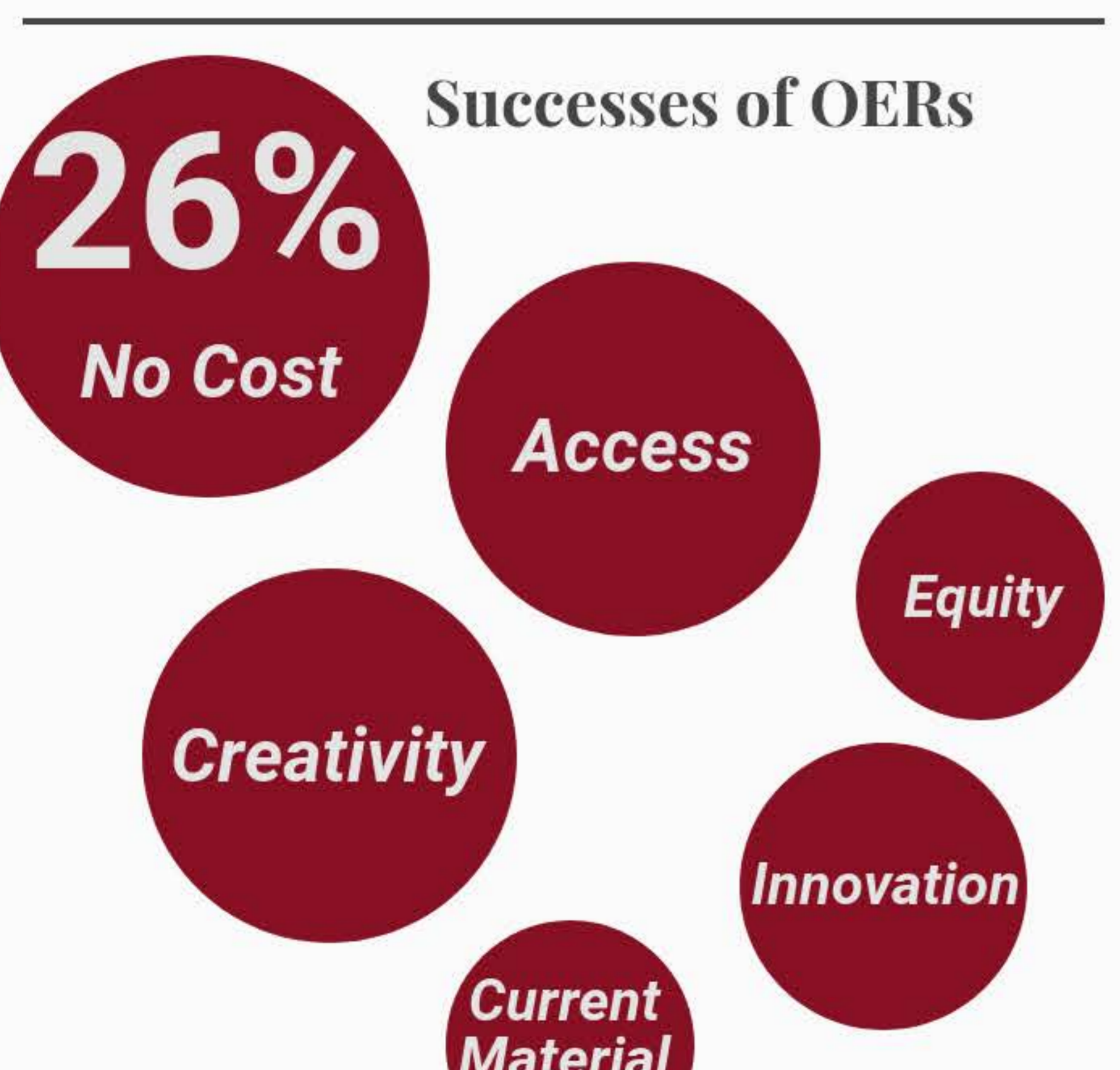

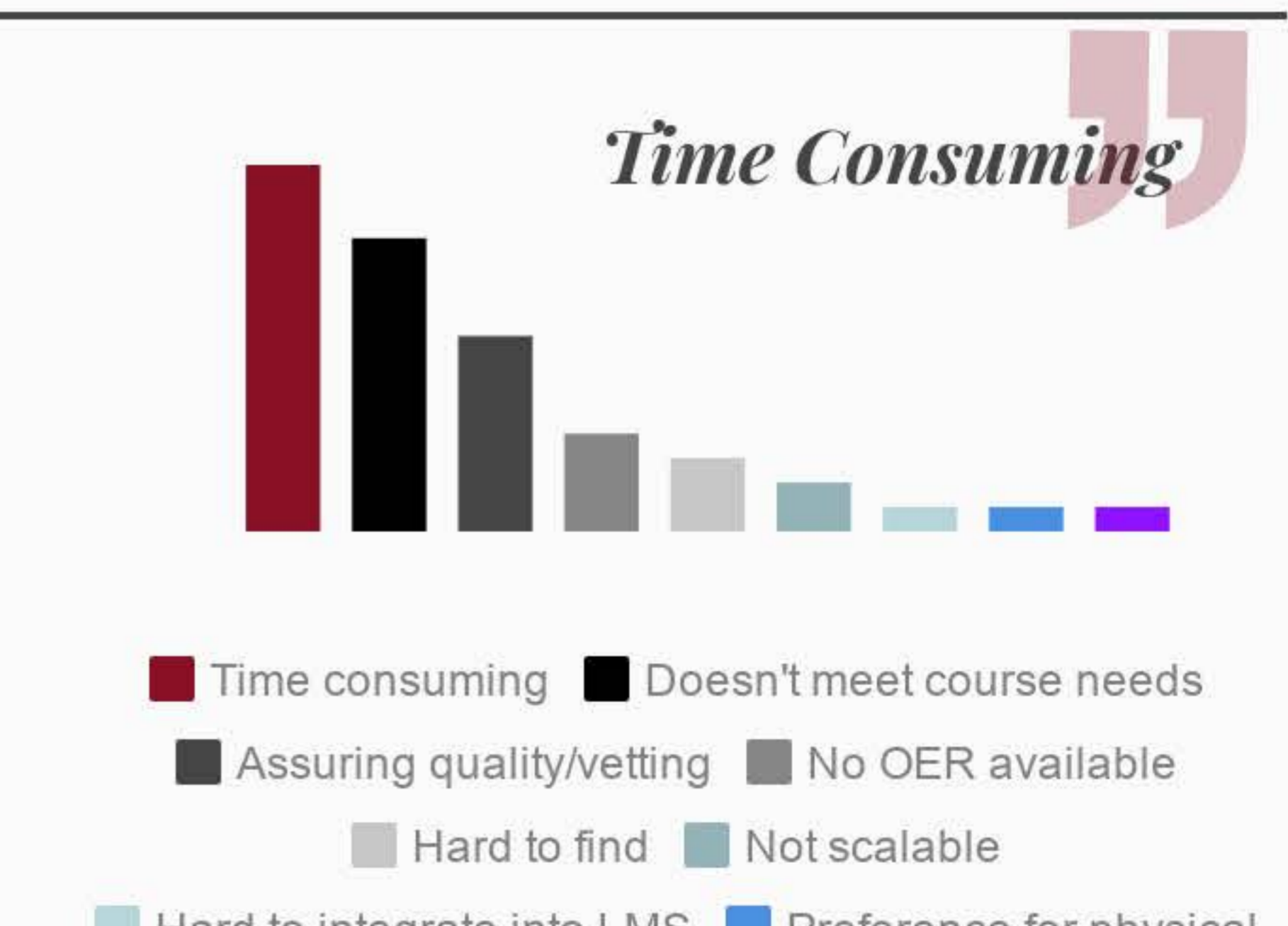
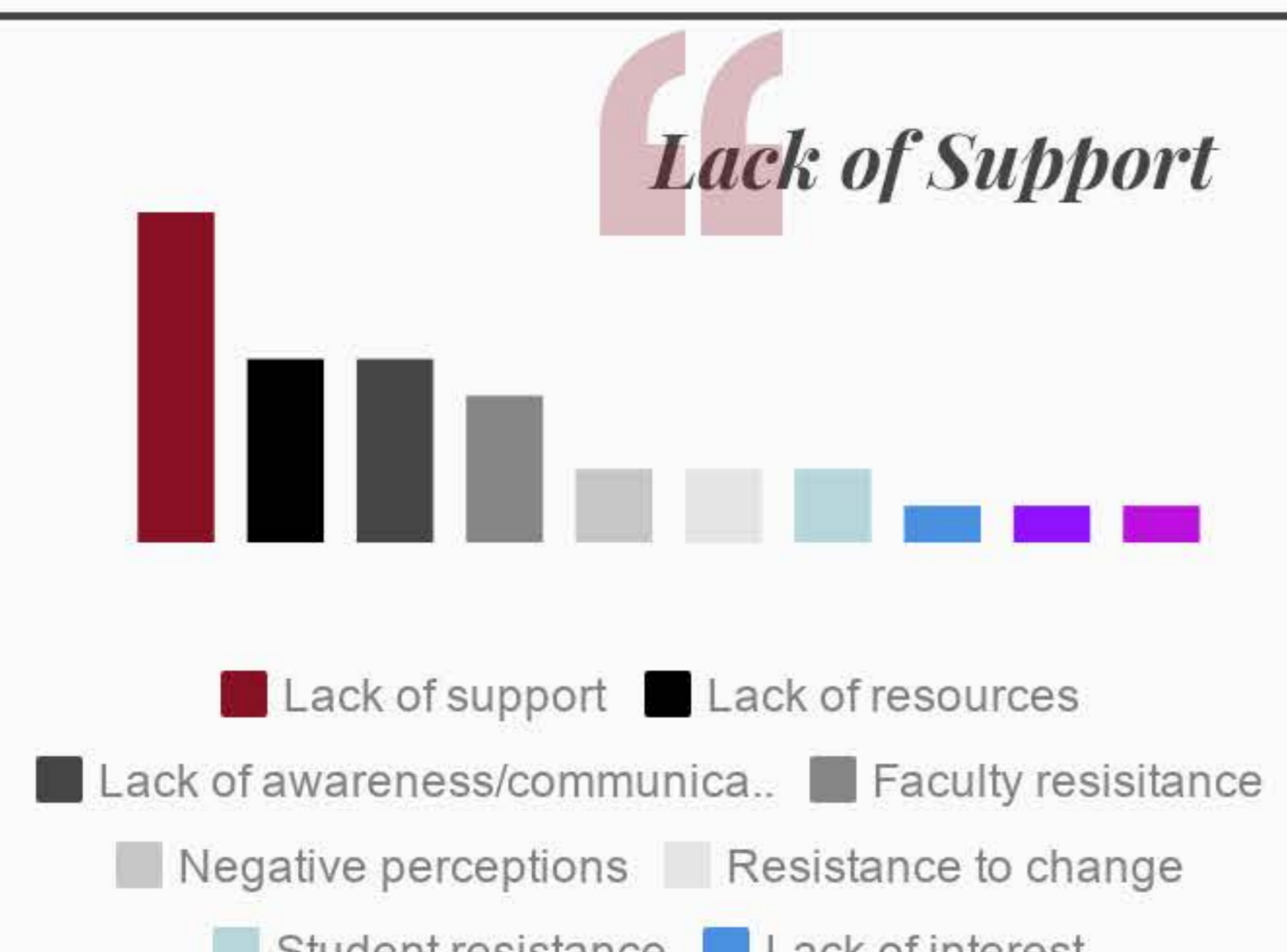
“The OER Community is missing the point by trying to recreate the textbook...Let's use current information.”
