MUSKIE INTRODUCES RESOLUTION ON EXPLORER SCOUT PROGRAM

Senator Edmund S. Muskie (D-Maine) has introduced in the Senate a resolution commemorating the first annual National Explorers Presidents Congress of the Boy Scouts of America, which takes place in Washington June 2-6.

In his remarks, Senator Muskie said, "The Boy Scouts' Exploring program provides a unique opportunity for more than 350,000 young men and women between the ages of 14 and 21 to gain first-hand knowledge of potential career fields such as law enforcement, local government, small business and conservation to name a few.

"Under the guidance of professionals in these fields, Explorers gain invaluable insights into their own career interests at the same time that they perform useful community services...

"I am proud to salute the first annual National Explorers Presidents' Congress, as well as all the outstanding young people who participate in the Exploring program throughout the nation."

The resolution, submitted with Senator Howard Baker of Tennessee, commended the Explorers "for their example and for their part in training future leaders for our Nation."
