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REMARKS BY SENATOR EDUMUND S. MUSKIE JEFFERSON-JACKSON DINNER, LINCOLN, NEBRASKA, SATURDAY, 24 APRIL 1971

IT IS A LONG WAY FROM THE ROCKY COAST OF MAINE

TO THE PLAINS OF NEBRASKA. BUT THERE IS NO GREAT DIFFERENCE

BETWEEN THE PEOPLE OF OUR STATES. IN OUR TWO STATES -- AS

IN THE OTHER FORTY-EIGHT -- I BELIEVE MOST AMERICANS WANT

THE SAME THING FROM THEIR COUNTRY.

WE ALL WANT TO WALK SAFELY ON ANY STREET, IN ANY NEIGHBORHOOD OF ANY COMMUNITY.

WE ALL WANT TO BE TREATED FAIRLY AND WITH RESPECT,

NO MATTER WHAT THE COLOR OF OUR SKIN, OR THE SPELLING OF

OUR LAST NAME.

WE ALL WANT THE RIGHT TO EARN A DECENT LIVING IN A DECENT JOB IN A GROWING AND HEALTHY ECONOMY.

WE ALL WANT GOOD HEALTH CARE AT A REASONABLE COST.

WE ALL WANT DECENT HOUSING, AND A CLEANER ENVIRONMENT, AND BETTER TRANSPORTATION.

WE ALL WANT OUR CHILDREN TO HAVE AN EQUAL CHANCE TO REACH THEIR OWN POTENTIAL.

WE WANT TO END THE SCOURGE OF POVERTY AND HUNGER.

WE WANT OUR NATION TO BE A RESPECTED FORCE FOR PEACE IN THE WORLD.

THESE ARE THE THINGS MEN AND WOMEN ARE CONCERNED.

WHITE IN EVERY SECTION OF THIS COUNTRY. THESE ARE THE THINGS

THEY WANT THEIR COVERNMENT TO BE CONCERNED WITH.

OUR GOALS SEEM VERY CLEAR.

OUR CAPACITY TO ACHIEVE THEM IS LESS CLEAR. WE
HAVE FALLEN SHORT SO OFTEN IN THE PAST MORE AND MORE AMERICANS
WONDER IF THE DEMOCRATIC SYSTEM HAS BROKEN DOWN.

TOO HANY AMERICANS DOUBT THAT OUR DEMOCRACY
CAN WORK.

I SOMETIMES WORRY ABOUT THE CAPACITY OF OUR
COUNTRY TO SURVIVE AS A DEMOCRACY. I WORRY WHEN I HEAR
THE SHRILL VOICES OF REPRESSION RAISED AGAINST A FREE
PRESS AND OUR YOUNG PEOPLE. I WORRY WHEN I HEAR TESTIMONY ABOUT MILITARY ESPIONAGE ON PRIVATE CITIZENS AND
ELECTED REPRESENTATIVES. I WORRY WHEN I DISCOVER THAT
EARTH DAY RALLIES ARE SUBJECT TO FBI SURVEILLANCE. I
WORRY WHEN THE MECHANISMS OF DEFENSE ARE TURNED AGAINST
THE CONSTITUTION, THE FOUNDATIONS OF AMERICAN DEMOCRACY.

THESE ACTIONS REINFORCE THE UNCERTAINTY OF

CITIZENS ABOUT THEIR GOVERNMENT, WHICH IS SUPPOSED TO

PROTECT THEM. THESE ACTIONS BREED FEAR. THEY BREED

DISRESPECT. THEY BREED SUSPICION AND DISTRUST IN PLACE

OF OPENNESS AND HONESTY. THEY BREED FEAR. THEY UNDERMINE

OUR CONFIDENCE AS INDIVIDUALS AND AS A NATION.

IF AMERICANS ARE TO HAVE CONFIDENCE IN EACH

OTHER, THEY MUST HAVE CONFIDENCE IN THEIR LEADERS. 40

HAVE CONFIDENCE IN THEIR LEADERS, AMERICANS MUST KNOW

WHERE THEIR LEADERS PROPOSE TO LEAD THEM, AND THEY MUST

THEY

KNOW THAT THEY ARE LEADING. AMERICANS MUST FEEL THAT THOSE

LEADERS UNDERSTAND THE GOALS OF THEIR PEOPLE.

IN INDOCRINA WIR ONLY JUST COAL IS AN END TO THE

CONFIDENCE MORE THAN THE WAR IN

RICHWING AND KILLING. WE CANNOT BROTH TO DO THAT UNTIL WE

[MOOCHINA, AMERICANA EVERY WHERE YEARN

ANNOINCE A DATE FOR OUR MITHDRAWAL. I BRITEVE THAT BATE

FOR R CLERRCUT AND DEFINITE COMMITMENT

CAN AND SHOULD BE NO LATER THAN DECEMBER 31, 1971.

TO END OUR INVOLUEMENT IN THAT WAR.

ADMINISTRATION COMPOSITION HAVE TORD US THAT A FIXED

DATE FOR WITHDRAWAL WILL TEAR THE COUNTRY APART. I SAY THAT

A FIXED DATE WILL GIVE THE AMERICAN PEOPLE SOME CONFIDENCE

THAT THEIR LEADERS DO INTEND A NEW BEGINNING FOR AMERICAN

THEY

FOREIGN POLICY. AMERICANS COULD HAVE A NEW CONFIDENCE

THAT WE INTEND TO USE OUR POWER, NOT TO IMPOSE OUR WILL

THROUGH FORCE OF ARMS, BUT TO LEND A HELPING HAND FOR

JUSTICE AND PEACE. THE KILLING OF AMERICANS AND ASIANS

MUST STOP. HONOR DIES IN RECOGNIZING SEMBLESO DESTRUCTION,

NOT CONTINUING OUR DART IN IT.

THOSE OF US WHO CALL FOR PRACE DO NOT SEER TO

WITHDRAW FROM THE WORLD. WE WANT TO HELP DUTID IT, NOT TO

DECTROY IT

WILL, AT LONG LAST WE TURN OUR ENERGIES TO THOSE TASKS

TO GOALS WHICH UNITE, NOT DIVIDE. WE WANT TO CREATE NOW

OPERATORITIES, NOT SETTLE OIL SCORES.

WE WANT TO HEAL THIS SOCIETY, BECAUSE WE CARE

AMERICANS KNOW THAT THE ECONOMIC.

ABOUT ITS PEOPLE: PROGLEMS WE FACE — UNEMPLOYMENT

INFLATION, DECLINING INCOMES — ARE DIRECTLY

RELATED TO THAT WAR.

LP I HAVE ANY COMPLAINT ABOUT THE MINON

ADMINISTRATION, IT IS THIS. THE NIMEN ADMINISTRATION

SHOWS NO STON THAT IT REALLY CARES ABOUT PROPER.

THE OF THIS REMINISTRATION

FOR TWENTY-SEVEN MONTHS WE HAVE BEEN HEARING

ABOUT THE NIXON GAME PLAN FOR THE ECONOMY. I HAVE

NO PLAN. I HAVE SEEN SOME PRACTIONS. AND I HAVE SEEN GAMES

PLAYED WINE MUR AMEDICAN DEODES.

YOU AND I HAVE SEEN UNEMPLOYMENT GO UP, PRICES
GO UP, AND JOB OPPORTUNITIES GO DOWN.

WHEN UNEMPLOYMENT IN LINCOLN GOES UP FORTY PERCENT AND UNEMPLOYMENT IN OMAHA GOES UP OVER SIXTY PERCENT IN TWO YEARS, THAT'S NOT A GAME. IT'S NOT A GAME WHEN 4500 MORE MEN AND WOMEN ARE LOOKING FOR JOBS IN THOSE TWO CITIES.

IT'S VETERANS COMING HOME FROM VIETNAM WITH NOTHING TO DO WHEN THEY GET HERE. IT'S FAMILIES GOING ON RELIEF, NOT BECAUSE THEY WANT TO, BUT BECAUSE THEY HAVE TO.

PARITY FOR THEIR CROPS, THAT'S NOT A GAME. WHEN TWO
THOUSAND FAMILY FARMERS A YEAR ARE GOING OUT OF BUSINESS
IN NEBRASKA, THAT'S NOT A GAME. IT'S FARMERS LOSING
NEARLY A BILLION DOLLARS IN INCOME FOR ONE YEAR. IT'S
YOUNG PEOPLE GOING TO THE CITIES, SEARCHING FOR JOBS THAT
AREN'T THERE. IT'S SMALL TOWNS, LOSING THEIR POPULATION,
FACED WITH HIGHER PROPERTY TAXES AND A BLEAK FUTURE.

I DON'T PRETEND TO HAVE THE ANSWER TO OUR FARM PROBLEM; BUT I DO KNOW THAT WHAT THE ADMINISTRATION HAS OFFERED IS THE WRONG ANSWER.

ANY FARM POLICY WHICH DRIVES FARM PRICES DOWN,
WHILE THE COST OF FARMING IS GOING UP, IS THE WRONG ANSWER.

ANY FARM POLICY WHICH DRIVES FARMERS OFF THE LAND, AND YOUNG PEOPLE OUT OF RURAL COMMUNITIES IS THE WRONG ANSWER.

ANY FARM POLICY WHICH FAILS TO GIVE FARMERS REAL BARGAINING POWER IN THE MARKETPLACE IS THE WRONG ANSWER.

AMERICA HAS A STAKE IN WHAT HAPPENS TO FARMERS

AND THEIR FAMILIES. FARMERS HAVE A RIGHT TO A PAIR RETURN

ON THEIR TIME AND THEIR INVESTMENT. THEY HAVE A RIGHT TO

BE REWARDED FOR THEIR EFFICIENCY.

THEY HAVE A RIGHT TO EXPECT THE DEMOCRATIC PARTY

TO DO MORE THAN CRITICIZE THE REPUBLICANS.

WE HAVE AN OBLIGATION TO FIND BETTER ANSWERS THAN
WE HAVE IN THE PAST FOR THE PROBLEMS OF MEETING OUR FOOD
AND FIBER NEEDS, ENCOURAGING EFFICIENCY ON THE FARM,
INSURING A FAIR RETURN FOR FARMERS, AND BUILDING HEALTHY
RURAL COMMUNITIES. SUCH AN APPROACH CANNOT BE CARRIED OUT
IN A VACUUM. IT IS ROOTED IN NATIONAL ECONOMIC POLICIES
AIMED AT MEETING THE NEEDS OF PEOPLE IN ALL PARTS OF OUR
COUNTRY.

NEEDS TO BE DONE - THE WYRKS OF PERCE -THE WORK OF BUILDING LIVES, AND SMALL TOWNS, RND GREAT CITTES. IT IS TIME WE UNDERSTOOD

CONTINUE TO MISMANAGE THE ECONOMY. THERE MIGHT BE, BUT

I DON'T THINK THE COUNTRY CAN AFFORD IT. THE TIME TO WERN
THE BOONOMY AROUND IS NOT, NOT 1972 OR 1973.

NOW IS THE TIME TO PUT PROPLE TO WORK BUILDING HOMES AND SCHOOLS.

NOW IS THE TIME TO GIVE OUR YOUNG MEN A CHANCE
TO BUILD A BETTER AMERICA, NOT KEEP THEM TIED DOWN IN THE
JUNGLES OF INDOCHINA.

NOW IS THE TIME TO GIVE AMERICANS A BIGGER

OPPORTUNITY TO USE THEIR GOD-GIVEN TALENTS, TO LIVE IN

DECENT HOUSING, TO SEE THEIR CHILDREN LEARN IN BETTER

SCHOOLS, TO KNOW THEIR PARENTS CAN GET BETTER MEDICAL CARE

WITHOUT GOING BANKRUPT, TO LIVE IN ATTRACTIVE COMMUNITIES

WHERE THEY AREN'T AFRAID TO WALK THE STREETS.

IF THE AMERICAN DREAM MRANS ASYTHING, IT MEANS A JOB OPPORTUNITY FOR EVERY MAN AND MOMAN WILLING AND ABLE TO WORK. IT MEANS A SHARE IN A GROWING ECONOMY FOR EVERY AMERICAN. THAT'S THE GOLL OF ANY POLITICAL PARTY WORTHY OF THE NAME. THAT'S MY GOAL.

WHEN FARMERS SUFFER; WHEN BLUE COLLAR WORKERS

AND WHITE COLLAR WORKERS IN AMERICA SUFFER, THEN AMERICA

SUFFERS. WE CAN'T LICK HARD-CORE UNEMPLOYMENT IN A WEAK

ECONOMY. WE CAN'T EDUCATE OUR CHILDREN THE WE'D LIKE,

OR GIVE AN EQUAL CHANCE TO EVERYONE, OR CLEAN UP POLLUTION,

OR IMPROVE LAW ENFORCEMENT, OR REBUILD OUR CITIES, UNLESS

THE ECONOMY IS GROWING AND PEOPLE HAVE JOBS.

WE CANNOT REALLY DO THIS JOB THAT'S MAY WE WELD A COVERNMENT WHICH CARES,

UNLESS AND UNTIL WE END THIS

NOT ABOUT WHAT IT CALLS THE SILENT MAJORITY, BUT ABOUT A

WORKING HOJOPITY,

DESTRUCTIVE WAR.

FUTURE, AS I SAID EARLIER, IS AN EIGHTY BILLION DOLLAR MILITARY BUDGET.

LAM NOT PROPOSING THAT WE BLIMINATE OR CUT DOWN ON OUR DEFENSES WITHOUT REGARD TO WORLD CONDITIONS.

WHAT I AM SUCCESSING IS THAT THE WAY TO BEGIN IS BY GETTING OUT OF THE QUICKSAND OF VIETNAM.

BUT I READ THAT THE PRESIDENT SAYS THAT
PEOPLE WHO TAKE THIS POSITION ARE ACTUALLY FOSTERING
A NEW FORM OF ISOLATIONISM.

THE PRESIDENT HAS DEFENDED HIS POSITION IN VIETNAM BY SAYING THAT AMERICA MUST NOT RETREAT FROM THE WORLD. ALSO, HE HAS SAID WE HAVE IMPORTANT RESPONSIBILITIES TO THE PEACE THAT WE CANNOT SPURN OR SHIRK.

I HAVE NO TROUBLE IN ACCEPTING THE POSITION
THAT THE UNITED STATES IS PART OF THE WORLD AND THAT
WE HAVE THE STRONGEST OBLIGATIONS TO THE KEEPING OF
THE PEACE. BUT I FIND IT DIFFICULT TO SEE HOW
INTELLIGENT AND HUMANE OPPOSITION TO THE WAR IN
VIETNAM FITS IN WITH ANY REASONABLE DEFINITION OF
ISOLATIONISM.

I BELIEVE THAT THE OPPOSITION OF THE AMERICAN PEOPLE TO THE CONTINUATION OF THE WAR IN VIETNAM -- I BELIEVE THAT THEIR OPPOSITION TO AN EXTENSION OR ESCALATION OF THAT WAR -- HAS NOTHING TO DO WITH ISOLATIONISM.

THE AMERICAN PEOPLE ARE WILLING TO ACCEPT
THEIR RESPONSIBILITIES TO OTHER PEOPLE IN THE WORLD,
BUT THEY DO NOT BELIEVE THAT WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING
IN VIETNAM, CAMBODIA, OR LAOS, IS A PROPER EXERCISE
OF THAT WORLD RESPONSIBILITY.

I DON'T BELIEVE IT IS ISOLATIONIST TO PROTEST THE DROPPING OF BOMBS ON VILLAGES.

I DON'T BELIEVE IT IS ISOLATIONIST TO PROTEST THE MANIPULATION OF OTHER GOVERNMENTS.

I DON'T BELIEVE IT IS ISOLATIONIST TO

PROTEST A POLICY THAT DECLARES OUR RESPECT FOR THE

PRINCIPLE OF SELF-DETERMINATION YET PROCEEDS TO

VIOLATE THAT PRINCIPLE.

I DON'T THINK IT IS ISOLATIONIST TO

PROTEST A MILITARY BUDGET OF EIGHTY BILLION DOLLARS A BUDGET WHICH COMMITTEES OF CONGRESS HAVE REPEATEDLY

CRITICIZED BECAUSE OF GROSS MISSPENDING, WASTE, AND
INCOMPETENCE.

I DON'T THINK IT IS ISOLATIONIST TO PROTEST
AN ECONOMIC POLICY THAT FINDS READY DOLLARS FOR ALL
SORTS OF MILITARY NEEDS WHICH IT REGARDS AS VITAL
TO OUR SECURITY BUT THAT DOESN'T REGARD SQUALOR,
SUFFERING, HOMELESSNESS, AND JOBLESSNESS AMONG
AMERICAN CITIZENS AS ANY THREAT TO OUR SECURITY
OR WELL-BEING.

I DON'T THINK IT IS ISOLATIONIST TO

PROTEST INJUSTICE AND TO INSIST THAT TRUE SECURITY

CAN COME ONLY WHEN EVERY AMERICAN HAS AN EQUAL

CHANCE.

I DON'T THINK IT IS ISOLATIONIST TO OPPOSE
THE IDEA THAT THE UNITED STATES CAN ACT AS A WORLD
POLICEMAN, KEEPING ORDER EVERYWHERE BY ITSELF.

I'M NOT OPPOSED TO AMERICAN COMMITMENTS

IN THE WORLD BUT I CONFESS I HAVE SOMEWHAT DIFFERENT

COMMITMENTS IN MIND FROM THE ONES THE PRESIDENT HAS

BEEN TALKING ABOUT.

I'D LIKE TO SEE THE UNITED STATES MAKE A COMMITMENT TO A STRONGER UNITED NATIONS - A UNITED NATIONS THAT HAS THE ABILITY TO KEEP THE PEACE ON A WORLD SCALE.

I'D LIKE TO SEE THE UNITED STATES MAKE A

COMMITMENT TO A WORLD UNDER LAW - ELIMINATING ANARCHY

AMONG NATIONS, PUTTING AN END TO THE WORLD ARMS RACE.

I'D LIKE TO SEE THE UNITED STATES MAKE A
COMMITMENT TO THE PROTECTION OF THE WORLD'S RESOURCES
IN THE HUMAN INTEREST.

I'D LIKE TO SEE THE UNITED STATES MAKE A
COMMITMENT TO WORK WITH ALL OTHER NATIONS TO KEEP
THE WORLD'S OCEANS FROM BEING POISONED, AND TO PROTECT
OUR ATMOSPHERE.

I'D LIKE TO SEE THE UNITED STATES COMMIT
ALL ITS MORAL POWER TO THE IDEA THAT A CONDITION OF
SANITY AND SAFETY CAN BE CREATED ON EARTH SO THAT
MAN NEITHER HAS TO KILL OR BE KILLED.

I'D LIKE, IN SHORT, TO SEE US MAKE INSPIRING
COMMITMENTS TO A PLANET MADE SAFE AND FIT FOR THE
HUMAN FAMILY.

THIS WORLD AND EVERYTHING IN IT BELONGS TO
THE PEOPLE WHO INHABIT IT. I CAN IMAGINE NO COMMITMENT
THAT WOULD GIVE THE AMERICAN PEOPLE A DEEPER SENSE OF
IDENTITY WITH THEIR OWN HISTORY THAN A COMMITMENT TO
HELP LIFT THE INSANE BURDEN OF WAR FROM THE WORLD'S



PEOPLES, AND TO HELP UPGRADE THE PROSPECTS OF THE HUMAN FAMILY FOR A DECENT AND JUST EXISTENCE.

THESE ARE THE KIND OF COMMITMENTS THAT

MAKE SENSE IN OUR TIME. THESE ARE THE COMMITMENTS

THAT I'M GOING TO CONTINUE TO TALK ABOUT AND WORK FOR.

ELBERT HUBBARD ONCE DESCRIBED AN EDITOR AS "A PERSON EMPLOYED ON A AME NEWS PAPER WHOSE BUSINESS IT IS TO SEPARATE THE WHEAT PROM THE CHAPP, AND TO SEE THAT THE CHAPP IS PRINTED."

WE HAUE MUCH IN COMMON. THE DIFFERENCE IS THAT WE SOMETIMES WRITE IT INTO LAW.

JOURNALISM CONSISTS IN ROYING WHITE PAPER AT TWO CENTS A POUND AND SELLING IT AT 10 CENTS A POUND.
