I WAS HONORED TO RECEIVE AND HAPPY TO ACCEPT YOUR INVITATION TO PAY TRIEUTE TO SENATOR MONDALE. I HAVE THE GREATEST ADMIRATION AND RESPECT FOR HIM. SENATOR MONDALE IS ONE OF THE FEW PROMINENT AND POWERFUL DEMOCRATIC SENATORS WHO HAVE DISPLAYED THE COURAGE, THE BRILLIANCE, AND THE FORTITUDE NOT TO RUN FOR PRESIDENT.

IS ALSO ONE OF THE MEN OF REAL STATURE MINNESOTA HAS GIVEN TO THE NATION. AND WHEN I THINK OF GREATNESS AND MINNESOTA, THERE COMES TO MIND IMMEDIATELY ANOTHER MAN WHOSE NAME IS KNOWN FROM COAST TO COAST BY YOUNG AND OLD ALIKE. WHENEVER I SPEAK FROM THE SAME PLATFORM WITH SENATOR
HUMPHREY -- AND I'VE LEARNED THIS FROM LONG EXPERIENCE -I HAVE THE GNAWING FEELING THAT I SHOULD ASK FOR EQUAL TIME
I DID ASK THE GOVERNOR ABOUT THAT DURING DINNER. HE SAID

A FRIEND WHO SEES HIM EVERYDAY.

PRITZ MONDALE IS A THOUGHTFUL MAN, A TOUGH MAN, A MAN OF PRINCIPLE. HE KNOWS WHAT THE PEOPLE OF MINNESOTA REALLY WANT -- A SENATOR WITH THE COURAGE TO SPEAK AND VOTE HIS CONSCIENCE, A SENATOR TO LEAD AND NOT TO FOLLOW PUBLIC OPINION.

LIKE HIS COLLEAGUE HUBERT HUMPHREY, FRITZ MONDALE HAS BEEN THAT KIND OF SENATOR. HIS VOICE HAS CHALLENGED US TO MAKE AMERICA'S REALITY EQUAL TO AMERICA'S RHETORIC. AND NO VOICE HAS SPOKEN MORE HONESTLY AND FRANKLY THAN HIS IN THE STRUGGLE FOR RACIAL EQUALITY, NATIONAL PROSPERITY, AND NEW PRIORITIES.

TIME AND AGAIN, ERITE MONDALE HAS STOOD ON THE FRONTIER OF SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC REFORM IN AMERICA. TIME AND AGAIN, THE SENATE AND THE COUNTRY HAVE RUSHED TO CATCH UP WITH HIM.

MINNESOTA SHOULD BE PROUD OF FRITZ MONDALE -- PROUD OF WHAT HE HAS SAID AND DONE AND PROUD OF THE CHANCE TO SEND HIM BACK TO THE SENATE NEXT YEAR.

THE DEMOCRATIC PARTY NEEDS LEADERS LIKE HIM -- AND SO DOES THE COUNTRY. FOR BEYOND ALL THE SPECIFIC BILLS AND PROGRAMS HE CAN CLAIM, BEHIND HIS WORDS AND HIS VOTES, FRITZ MONDALE UNDERSTANDS A SIMPLE BUT VITAL TRUTH ABOUT AMERICA'S PASSAGE THROUGH THE 1970s. THE ONLY WAY TO BRING PEOPLE TOGETHER IN OUR NATION IS TO BRING PEOPLE FULLY INTO OUR NATIONAL LIFE.

IN THESE LAST, DIFFICULT YEARS, AMERICANS EVERYWHERE HAVE WORRIED ABOUT THE FUTURE AND THE PATE OF AMERICA. JUST OVER A DECADE AGO, IT SEEMS, WE REALLY WERE ONE PEOPLE AND ONE COUNTRY. BUT UNDER THE SURFACE CALM, THE CRISIS WAS ALREADY BUILDING. JOHN KENNETH GALBRAITH CALLED OURS AN AFFLUENT SOCIETY -- BUT HE WARNED US THAT TENS OF MILLIONS WERE STILL TRAPPED IN POVERTY. PRESIDENT EISENHOWER TALKED ABOUT A JUST SOCIETY -- BUT HE CONCEDED THAT MILLIONS MORE SUPFERED PREJUDICE AND DISCRIMINATION. COLLEGE STUDENTS WERE LABELLED THE SILENT GENERATION -- BUT YOU COULD HEAR THE FIRST MURMURS OF DISSENT ON CAMPUS AND AMONG THE YOUNG.

BY THE MIDDLE AND THE END OF THE 1960s, NO ONE NEEDED ANYONE'S HELP TO SEE AN IMPENDING CRISIS. THE CRISIS WAS COMPLETELY UPON US -- IN YOUR TOWN AND IN MINE -- AND EVEN WITH OUR OWN SONS AND DAUGHTERS.

THERE IS NO WAY TO GO EACK. THERE IS NO WAY TO RECAPTURE THE EARLIER TIME WHEN NATIONAL QUIET WAS MISTAKEN FOR NATIONAL UNITY, WHEN THE PAULTS AND FAILINGS OF THE AMERICAN CONDITION WERE SUBMERGED, VISIBLE ONLY TO THEIR VICTIMS AND MORE OR LESS TOLERATED BY THE REST OF US. THE BLACK AND THE YOUNG, THE POOR AND THE NEAR POOR SIMPLY WILL NOT ACCEPT A NEW ERA OF NEGLECT AND INSENSITIVITY. THEY KNOW IT WOULD BE WRONG FOR THEM -- AND WE SHOULD KNOW THAT IT WOULD BE WRONG FOR AMERICA.

IF WE CARE ABOUT OUR COUNTRY'S SURVIVAL AND ITS SOUL,
OUR ONLY CHOICE IS A DIFFERENT KIND OF UNITY -- A UNITY OF
PEOPLE WHO HAVE AN EQUAL VOICE AND A TRUE STAKE IN THE SYSTEM.
OUR REAL AND URGENT TASK IS TO REFORM OUR SOCIETY IN ORDER
TO LIVE TOGETHER THROUGH ALL THE YEARS TO COME.

WE MUST RESTORE OUR ECONOMY -- SO WORKERS WILL NO LONGER HAVE TO LOSE THEIR HOPE AND THEIR SELF-RESPECT IN WELFARE AND RELIEF LINES. YESTERDAY, WE ALL READ THAT UNEMPLOYMENT NOW EQUALS THE HIGHEST LEVEL IN THE LAST NINE YEARS. AND BEHIND THE NUMBERS AND THE PERCENTAGES, THERE ARE PEOPLE -- PEOPLE WHO MAY NOT MEET NEXT MONTH'S MORTGAGE PAYMENT AND PROBABLY HAVE NOTHING LEFT OF LAST YEAR'S SAVINGS.

THEIR PLIGHT REQUIRES IMMEDIATE AND SPECIFIC ACTION
IN WASHINGTON. IT REQUIRES A TEMPORARY TAX CUT FOR LOWER
AND MIDDLE INCOME AMERICANS AND TEMPORARY EXPENDITURE
INCREASES IN MAJOR SOCIAL PROGRAMS. THE ADMINISTRATION'S
ECONOMIC GAME PLAN HAS FAILED. IT HAS GIVEN US FEWER JOBS
AND HIGHER PRICES. AND THE ANSWER IS NOT THE RECENT FEDERAL
TAX BREAK FOR GIANT CORPORATIONS. THE ANSWER IS NOT THE
"TRICKLE DOWN" THEORY OF ECONOMICS -- THAT IF ENOUGH WEALTHY
PEOPLE BUY LIMOUSINES, THERE WILL BE MORE JOBS FOR CHAUPFEURS.

AND AFTER WE REBUILD PROSPERITY, THERE WILL STILL BE
SO MUCH WORK TO DO. WE MUST MAKE OUR PROSPERITY EQUITABLE.

DETERIORATED HOUSING AND DECLINING CITIES AND DEFICIENT SCHOOLS
HAVE HURT AMERICANS OF EVERY RACE IN EVERY SECTION. THE

SKYROCKETING COSTS OF MEDICAL CARE HAVE CONSIGNED THE POOR TO

OFTEN INEFFICIENT AND INHUMAN PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICES -- AND

THEY HAVE LEFT THE HIDDLE CLASS CAUGHT SQUARELY IN THE MIDDLE -
TOO WELL-OFF TO QUALIFY FOR GOVERNMENT HELP -- TOO PRESSURED

TO PAY FOR COMPREHENSIVE INSURANCE.

WE CANNOT SOLVE SUCH INJUSTICES MERELY BY TELLING

AMERICANS TO SETTLE FOR THEM. WE MUST MAKE FUNDAMENTAL CHANGES -REVENUE SHARING, WELFARE REPORM, GUARANTEED PUBLIC SERVICE

JOBS, AND NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE. WE MUST PROTECT THE RIGHT

OF MINORITIES TO SHARE IN THE RESOURCES OF OUR COUNTRY.

IT WILL TAKE TIME -- AND IT WILL COST MONEY. IT WILL DEPEND ON OUR WILLINGNESS TO DEFEND RACTAL AND SOCIAL JUSTICE AGAINST ENTRENCHED INTERESTS. AND IT WILL FAIL WITHOUT TAX REFORMS TO PUT THE BURDENS OF CHANGE WHERE THEY BELONG -- ON THE INDIVIDUALS AND INSTITUTIONS WHICH CAN AFFORD TO PAY THE BILL. PROGRESS FOR THE POOR FINANCED ON THE BACKS OF THE NEAR POOR WOULD DEFEAT ITS OWN PURPOSE.

WE CAN BEGIN TO REUNIFY AMERICA BY CREATING A SOCIETY OF OPPORTUNITY FOR AMERICANS OF EVERY RACE. BUT THERE IS A PINAL CRUCIAL STEP. WE MUST TURN OUR ENERGIES FROM THE TASKS OF DEATH ABROAD TO THE TASKS OF LIFE AT HOME. WE MUST END THE WAR IN VIETNAM BY THE END OF THE YEAR.

ONLY THEN, WILL THE YOUNG AND MILLIONS OF OTHERS BELIEVE
AGAIN IN THE ABILITY OF OUR NATION TO RESPOND TO THE WILL OF
OUR PEOPLE. ONLY THEN, CAN WE MUSTER THE WEALTH TO DO WHAT
MUST BE DONE IN OUR OWN CITIES AND NEIGHBORHOODS. AND THE
SAVINGS OF PEACE MUST GO TO THE WORK OF PEACE -- NOT TO
PREPARATIONS FOR MORE WAR. A DEFENSE BUDGET BILLIONS OF DOLLARS
TOO HIGH WILL NOT ENHANCE OUR SECURITY IN THE WORLD -- AND
IT WILL SLOW OUR PROGRESS IN AMERICA.

IN THE LAST TWO YEARS, I HAVE TRAVELLED THIS COUNTRY
AND TALKED TO ITS PEOPLE. AND IN A THOUSAND DIFFERENT WAYS,
THEY HAVE BEEN TELLING ME WHAT FRITZ MONDALE HAS BEEN TELLING
THE SENATE.

WE MUST GIVE EVERY CITIZEN OF AMERICA A CHANCE TO LIVE IN A PROSPEROUS ECONOMY AND A FAIR SOCIETY.

WE MUST CARE ABOUT THE DESPAIR AND THE FRUSTRATION WHICH STRETCHES FROM HARLEN TO ST. PAUL TO SEATTLE.

WE MUST HEAL OUR DIVISIONS AND UNIFY OUR PEOPLE.

THERE IS A THIN MARGIN BETWEEN THE FUTURE OF AMERICA AND THE FAILURE OF AMERICA. FRITZ MONDALE HAS BEEN FIGHTING TO WIDEN THAT MARGIN. HE HAS BEEN FIGHTING TO STRENGTHEN THE FRAGILE COMMON ENTERPRISE WE CALL OUR OWN COUNTRY.

I THINK HE WILL SUCCEED -- AND I THINK WE WILL SUCCEED.

I THINK WE WILL MAKE AMERICA GOOD ENOUGH TO REMAIN GREAT.

IN MINNESOTA AND IN THE NATION, WHATEVER WE CAN DO, AND WHATEVER WE DREAM WE CAN DO, WE MUST BEGIN NOW.

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
