Senator Edmund S. Muskie, D-Maine, today announced the appointment of Charles J. Micoleau of Augusta, Maine as a Special Assistant on his Senatorial staff, effective February 2.

Mr. Micoleau will be responsible for scheduling and other administrative and legislative duties. He is now Legislative Research Director for the Maine Democratic State Committee, a position he has held since January, 1968. He took a leave of absence from January to June, 1969, to develop a manpower recruitment and training program for public assistance recipients from the Maine Department of Health and Welfare. During that time he was actively involved in the coordination of Federal and State manpower programs.

Mr. Micoleau received a B.A. from Bowdoin College in 1963 and an M.A. in economic development from Johns Hopkins University's School of Advanced International Studies in 1965.

Mr. Micoleau was born February 8, 1942, the son of Mr. and Mrs. LeBrec Micoleau of Pleasantville, New York. He is married to the former Judith Frary of Marblehead, Massachusetts, and the couple has a son, Tyler.
