FORT KENT _-- Senator Edmund S. Muskietonight called the Casco Bay island senset plan which has been proposed by the U.S. Departmentzof the Interior "an imaginative and far-sighted proposal."

Muskie said: "Following the cooperative federal-state approach we used in preserving the Allagash Waterway, the plan offers Maine people a chance to join in a federal state and local; public and private program to protect and enhance are of our most precious resourses."

Senator Muskie worked out the Allagash Waterway Program with the former Secretary of Interior Steweart Udall. In that plan, the Secretary used his discretionary funds under the Land and Water Conservation Act to pay half the cost of land acquisition and developmenta of the waterway under a plan developed by the Maine legislaterure and approved by Maine voters.

"The Bureau of Qutdoar Recreation has made another substantial contribution to Maine and its environmental improvement. I look forward to working with the Bureau and my colleagues in support of the objectives of the progosal."

The preservation plan, which is part of the National Trusts Act, has been was developed by the Bureau of Outdoor Recreation of the U.S.Department of Interior and will be submitted to Congress for approval.
