The President's statement isn't based on an understanding of the legislative history of the two proposals. It was made clear in both the Senate and House discussions of the Conference Reports on S. 1075 that the Council and the Office of Environmental Quality represented an integrated approach to environmental problems. The Office is designed to provide staff support for the Council. There is no surplus of staff involved. If the Council is to do the substantive job contemplated by the Congress, it will have to have the Office of Environmental Quality.
