EXCERPTS FROM THE REMARKS OP SENATOR EDMUND S. MUSKIE AT LAWRENCE HIGH SCHOOL AMERICAN LEGION DEPARTMENT OF MAINE, FAIRFIELD, MAINE JUNE 19, 1970 - 2:00 p.m.

LITTLE MORE THAN HALF A EENTURY AGO,

A GROUP OF CITIZEN-SOLDIERS MET IN PARIS.

THEY WERE WEARY OF WAR.

THEY WERE PASSIONATELY DEVOTED TO

THEIR COUNTRY ACROSS THE ATLANTIC.

AND THEY FORMED AN ORGANIZATION

TO WHICH YOU NOW PROUDLY BELONG ... BASED

ON THE VALUES THEY SHARED TOGETHER ... OF

LIBERTY... OF COMRADESHIP ... OF PEACE.

NOW, AS IN 1919, MANY AMERICANS, AT

HOME AND ABROAD, ARE WEARY OF WAR.

NOW, AS THEN, MOST AMERICANS ARE

PASSIONATELY DEVOTED TO THEIR COUNTRY.

AND NOW, IT IS AGAIN INCUMBENT ON US, ESPECIALLY THOSE OF US WHO HAVE WITNESSED AND FELT THE PAIN OF WAR, TO AFFIRM THOSE

VALUES WE SHARE TOGETHER.

SOME EIGHTEEN YEARS AGO, ADLAI STEVENSON SPOKE TO THE LEGION IN NEW YORK CITY. I

BELIEVE THAT WHAT HE STATED THEN IS MOST

TIMELY TODAY.

"IT WAS", HE SAID, "ALWAYS ACCOUNTED

A VITRUE IN A MAN TO LOVE HIS COUNTRY.

WITH US IT IS NOW SOMETHING MORE THAN A VIRTUE. IT IS A NECESSITY, A CONDI-TION OF SURVIVAL. WHEN AN AMERICAN SAYS THAT HE LOVES HIS COUNTRY, HE MEANS NOT ONLY THAT HE LOVES THE NEW ENGLAND HILLS, THE PRAIRIES GLISTEN-ING IN THE SUN, THE WIDE AND RISING PLAINS, THE GREAT MOUNTAINS, AND THE SEA. HE MEANS THAT HE LOVES AN INNER AIR, AN INNER LIGHT IN WHICH PREEDOM LIVES AND IN WHICH A MAN CAN DRAW A BREATH OF SELF-RESPECT. MEN WHO HAVE OFFERED THEIR LIVES FOR THEIR COUNTRY. KNOW THAT PATRIOTISM IS NOT THE PEAR

OF SOMETHING; IT IS THE LOVE OF

SOMETHING."

THERE SHOULD BE NO DOUBT, THEN, THAT MEMBERS OF THIS LEGION <u>DO</u> LOVE THIS LAND... THE DREAM OF AMERICA AS WELLINES + THE OPPORTUNITY OF AMERICA.

YOU HAVE LEFT THESE SHORES WHEN CALLED TO DO SO.

YOU HAVE GONE TO BATTLE, IN THE HONEST BELIEF THAT YOU WOULD HELP DEPEND LIBERTY

AND PROMOTE JUSTICE.

AND YOU HAVE RETURNED, WHEN THE GUNS

ARERE SILENCED, TO WORK THE LAND ... TO

ENGAGE IN COMMERCE...TO PRACTICE A PRO-PESSION.A.AND TO ENJOY PREEDOM.

YOU DID NOT FIGHT FOR PERSONAL GAIN... FOR MERE ADVENTURE...OR FOR IMPERIAL CON-QUEST. BUT YOU FOUGHT TO BRING PEACE AS QUICKLY AS POSSIBLE. NOT ONLY FOR YOUR OWN SECURITY, BUT FOR THAT OF YOUR CHILDREN.

AND NOW MANY OF YOU ARE PUZZLED, AND PER-HAPS EVEN ANGERED, BY YOUR CHILDREN, OR YOUR CHILDREN'S CHILDREN...BY THE LENGTH OF THEIR HAIR...THE CUT OF THEIR CLOTHES...

OR THE SOUND OF THEIR RHETORIC.

YET I SUGGEST THAT THESE SYMBOLS OF YOUTH ARE NOT CAUSE FOR ALARM...POR VIN-DICTIEE WORDS...OR FOR VIOLENT ACTS. BECAUSE I BELIEVE THAT, IN SUBSTANCE, THE VAST MAJORITY OF OUR YOUNG PEOPLE WISH TO IMPROVE AMERICANNOT TO REJECT HER. THEY WISH AMERICA TO BE UNITED, NOT INSECURE. THEY WISH TO BE PROUD OF AMERICA, NOT DISHEARTENED ABOUT HER.

AND ALTHOUGH MANY OF THEM MAY SINCERELY BELIEVE THAT THE WAR WE ARE PRE-SENTLY ENGAGED IN IS NOT WORTHY OF AMERICA... IS NOT WORTHY OF WHAT <u>YOU</u> HELPED TO PRE-SERVE AND TO BUILD...THEY WOULD, I AM CONVINCED, STRONGLY DEFEND AMERICA OF AMERICA HERSELF WERE THREATENED BY PORCE OF ARMS.

BEAR IN MIND THAT MANY OF YOUR CHILDREN, AND MINE, WILL NOT REACH THE AGES OF MANY OF US HERE, UNTIL AFTER THE YEAR 2000. THEY ARE WRGING US...BY TEACH-INS...BY <u>PEACEFUL</u> PROTESTS...BY LOBBYING EFFORTS...TO SAY YES, WE <u>DO</u> UNDERSTAND, WE <u>DO</u> CARE, AND WE <u>WILL</u> TRY. WHETHER OUR CHILDREN AND GRAND-CHILDREN LOOK BACK ON US ONE DAY WITH PRIDE, OR WITH SHAME, WILL DEPEND ON WHETHER WE HAVE THE DECENCY TO HEAR THEM OUT, AND THE GOOD SENSE TO RESPOND TN AN INTELLIGENT MANNER, AS DEMUND BURKE PUT IT, IT WILL DEPEND ON OUR ABILITY "SO TO BE PATRIOTS AS NOT TO FORGET WE ARE GENTLEMEN",

POR THE BASIC DEVOTION TO AMERICA WHICH OUR YOUNG PEOPLE POSSESS, IS THE S AME WHETHER THEY ARE IN SCHOOL OR IN A DISTANT JUNGLE...AND IT IS NOTMMEANT TO CONTRADICT-OUR OWN ALLEGIANCE.

THEIR PATRIOTISM, LIKE YOURS, IS BASED ON THOSE AMERICAN INSTINCTS OF COOPERATION, PAIRNESS, TOLERANCE AND UNDERSTANDING WHICH TRANSCEND DIFFERENCES IN AGE, IN OCCUPATION,

IN POLITICAL PERSUASION.

THEIR PATRIOTISM, LIKE YOURS, IS DIRECTED TOWARD POSITIVE GOALS...OF FREEDOM. AND SECURITY...AND MUTUAL RESPECT.

THEIR PATRIOTISM, LIKE YOURS, CAN DO

THAT IS WHY I BELIEVE AMERICA IS NOT THE PLACE, AND 1970 IS NOT THE TIME, FOR ANY OF US TO ESCAPE BEHIND OUR OWN PERSONAL BANNER, AND CALL <u>IT</u> THE ONLY TRUE PATRIOTISM. INSTEAD, PATRIOTISM REQUIRES US <u>ALL</u> TO HAVE THE COURAGE TO TALK SENSIBLY TO EACH OTHER...TO REFRAIN FROM SENSELESS. RAGE...TO TRY CROSSING THE BORDERS WHICH SEEM TO DIVIDE US. IT REQUIRES A SERIOUS UNDERSTANDING OF THE FEELINGS OF OTHERS WHOSE VIEWS ON A PARTICULAR ISSUE MAY BE DIFFERENT...WHO RESPECT THE GLAG IN A QUIET MANNER...WHO BELIEVE IN AMERICA, BUT NOT IN THE WAR.

I BELIEVE WE <u>GAN</u> PRACTICE THIS PATRIOTISM... WE <u>GAN</u> APPROACH THE PUTURE GTOGETHER... WE <u>CAN</u> SHAPE A WHOLE SOCIETY.. BUT WE MUST WANT TO TRY TO REACH OUT TO YOUNG AMERICANS, TO TRUST THEIR SINCERITY, AND THEIR PATRIOTISM. I KNOW THAT YOU CAN.

FOR, AS THE PREAMBLE TO THE CONSTI-
