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## Remarks by Senator Edmund S. Muskie at the Iron Shipbuilder's Conference

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REMARKS BY SENATOR EDMUND S. MUSKIE (D-MAINE) TO THE IRON SHIPBUILDER'S CONFERENCE, WASHINGTON, D.C., MARCH 26, 1964.

I AM GRATEFUL FOR THE OPPORTUNITY TO BE WITH YOU, TODAY, IF ONLY BRIEFLY. IT IS ALWAYS A PLEASURE TO BE IN A GROUP THAT INCLUDES MY GOOD FRIEND, LONNIE YOUNG. FURTHERMORE, I KNOW THAT YOU AND I SHARE A CONCERN OFER OUR NATION'S FUTURE IN SHIPPING AND NAVAL CAPABILITY.

MAINE IS STILL A SEAFARING STATE WITH A PROUD TRADITION OF BUILDING FINE SHIPS FOR TRADE AND DEFENSE. FROM THE LITTLE SHALLOP BUILT AT THE MOUTH OF THE KENNEBEC RIVER TO THE MODERN MISSILE FRIGATES BEING BUILT AT THE BATH IRON WORKS AND THE POLARIS AND ATTACK NUCLEAR SUBMARINES BEING BUILT AT KITTERY THE PRODUCTS OF OUR SHIPBUILDERS HAVE EXCITED THE ADMIRATION AND THE ENVY OF THE WORLD. WE WANT THAT TRADITION TO CONTINUE -- AS IT SHOULD.

I WANT TO TAKE THESE FEW MINUTES TO TALK WITH YOU ABOUT POLITICS --- IN ITS BROADEST SENSE. THIS IS AN ELECTION YEAR



AND A GOOD TIME TO CONSIDER THAT LIFEBLADD OF OUR DEMOCRATIC INSTITUTIONS, POLITICAL ACTION.

THE VERY ESSENCE OF OUR POLITICAL LIFE IS CHOOSING. WE WON THAT RIGHT MORE THAN 175 YEARS AGO WHEN WE WON OUR INDEPENDENCE FROM THE ERITISH EMPIRE. AFTER A HALTING AND UNSUCCESSFUL START UNDER THE ARTICLES OF CONFEDERATION THE FOUNDING FATHERS CHOSE OUR FEDERAL CONSTITUTION - NOW THE OLDEST WRITTEN CONSTITUTION IN THE WORLD.

FROM 1787 UNTIL TODAY WE HAVE BEEN MAKING CHOICES ON THE KIND OF GOVERNMENT WE WANT, ON THE ACTIONS WE WANT TO TAKE AS A PEOPLE, AND ON THE RESPONSIBILITIES WE MUST ASSUME AT HOME AND ABROAD.

WHAT DOES MAKING CHOICES INVOLVE?

FIRST, IN ORDER TO MAKE A CHOICE YOU MUST BE CONCERNED. YOU MUST CARE ABOUT YOUR COUNTRY, ABOUT YOUR FELLOW MAN, ABOUT THE PEOPLES OF THE WORLD. YOU DO CARE, OR YOU WOULDN'T BE HERE.

THE SECOND STEP IN MAKING INTELLIGENT CHDICES IS TO BE INFORMED --- TO KNOW THE ALTERNATIVE COURSES OF ACTION WHICH ARE OPEN TO YOU. TOO MANY PEOPLE IN OUR SOCIETY MAKE CHOICES WITHOUT REALLY KNOWING WHAT THE CHOICES ARE. THEY ARE TOO READY TO TAKE THE FIRST CHOICE THAT COMES ALONG. OR, SOMETIMES, THEY WILL TAKE THE EASY CHOICE , THE ONE WITH NO RISK.

IN MAKING CHOICES AND VALUE JUDGMENTS IT IS ESSENTIAL TO KNOW THE ALTERNATIVES AND TO KNOW THE GOOD AND THE BAD IN EACH OF THE ALTERNATIVES. THERE ARE NO BLACK AND WHITE CHOICES. THERE IS SOME GOOD AND SOME BAD IN ALL CHOICES.

THE NEXT STEP IN MAKING A CHOICE -- HAVING DEVELOPED A CONCERN AND HAVING WEIGHED THE ALTERNATIVES -- IS TO MAKE A SELECTION AS IF YOU HAD A STAKE IN IT. ON POLITICAL CHOICES YOU SHOULD MAKE YOUR DECISION AS IF YOU WERE THE PRESIDENT, THE GOVERNOR, THE MAXOR, THE SENATOR OR THE REPRESENTATIVE WHO HAS TO PUT HIS JUDCMENT ON THE LINE. MAKING A CHOICE AS AN UNINVOLVED AND DISINTERESTED EXSTANDER IS MAKING NO CHOICE AT ALL.

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IN MAKING A CHOICE ANY RESPONSIBLE PUBLIC OFFICIAL MUST BE WILLING TO TAKE TWO RISKS: (2) HE MUST BE WILLING TO TAKE THE RISK OF MAKING AN UNPOPULAR CHOICE; AND (2) HE MUST BE WILLING TO TAKE THE RISK OF MAKING A MISTAKE.

LITTLE MEN SELDOM MAKE BIG MISTAKES, AND SELDOM LEARN FROM THE MISTAKES THEY MAKE. BIG MEN SOMETIMES DO MAKE BIG MISTAKES, BUT THEY LEARN FROM THEM.

AS A PUBLIC OFFICIALSI WOULD NOT WANT YOU TO TAKE MY VIEWS WITHOUT QUESTION. AS CITIZENS WITH A STAKE IN A FREE SOCIETY I WANT YOU TO TEST MY IDEAS, MY PROBOALS, AND MY PROGRAMS. I WANT YOU TO TEST BOTH POLITICAL PARTIES.

THE TESTING OF IDEAS, THE FIXING OF RESPONSIBILITY, AND THE CHALLENGE OF POLITICAL CONTROVERSY ARE ESSENTIAL TO A DEMOCRATIC SOCIETY. OTHERESMAY SHUDDER AT OUR FREEDOM, BUT WE ARE NOT AFRAID. WE HAVE LEARNED THAT FREEDOM WILL WORK.

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THE CHOICES WE MAKE IN THE ATMOSPHERE OF FREE DEBATE ARE THE FIRST STEPS TOWARD MAKING THE WORLD A BETTER PLACE FOR ALL ME.

BUT MAKING FREEDOM WORK IS MORE THAN A MATTER OF MAKING CHOICES. WE MUST ACT ON OUR CHOICES. WE MUST BE WILLING TO MOVE SOCIETY, TO MOVE OUR NATION, TO MOVE AS INDIVIDUALS.

FORTUNATELY FOR OURSELVES AND FOR THE FREE WORLD, AMERICA WAS PEOPLED BY THOSE WHO WERE MOVERS. WE WORKED TOGETHER TO SPAN THE CONTINENT, TO EROADEN THE OPPORTUNITIES FOR EDUCATION, TO ENCOURAGE ECONOMIC GROWTH, TO ENLARGE THE SCOPE OF FREEDOM, TO MEET THE NEEDS OF THE POOR, THE ILL AND THE DISABLED, AND TO PROTECT OURSELVES FROM OUR ENEMIES, FOREIGN AND DOMESTIC.

IN JANUARY I WENT TO CALIFORNIA. ON MY WAY I STOPPED IN INDIANAPOLIS TO SPEAK TO A STEELWORKERS LEGISLATIVE CONFERENCE. ON THE WALL OF THE HOTEL WHERE I STAYED I FOUND A PLAQUE COMMEMORATING



A SPEECH MADE BY ABRAHAM LINCOLN IN INDIANAPOLIS ON HIS WAY TO HIS FIRST INAUGURATION.

IN THAT SPEECH LINCOLN SAID: "I APPEAL TO YOU TO CONSTANTLY BEAR IN MIND THAT NOT WITH POLITICIANS, NOT WITH PRESIDENTS, NOT WITH OFFICE-SPEECERS BUT WITH YOU IS THE QUESTION: SHALL THE UNION AND SHALL THE LIBERTIES OF THIS COUNTRY BE PRESERVED TO THE LATEST GENERATIONS?"

LINCOIN BELIEVED IN THE UNION. HE BELIEVED IN THE USE OF GOVERNMENT. HE HAD FAITH THAT THE PEOPLE COULD GOVERN THEMSELVES.

LINCOIN PRESERVED THE UNION AND FREED THE SLAVES -- AND HE DID MORE. HIS ADMINISTRATION -- IN 1862 -- GAVE US FEDERAL AID TO EDUCATION ON A LARGE SCALE, THROUGH THE MORRILL LAND GRANT COLLEGE ACT. HIS ADMINISTRATION -- THAT SAME YEAR -- OPENED THE WEST TO THE POORT THROUGH THE HOMESTEAD ACT. HIS ADMINISTRATION -- THAT SAME YEAR -- USED THE WEALTH OF THE NATION TO STIMULATE COMMERCE FROM COAST TO COAST THROUGH THE RAILFOAD LAND GRANT ACT.

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I LIKE TO REMIND MY REPUBLICAN FRIENDS OF THIS BIT OF HISTORY. I SUSPECT PRESIDENT LINCOLN WOULD HAVE ENDORSED THESE WORDS OF PRESIDENT JOHNSON, WHO SAID:

"I REGARD ACHIEVEMENT OF THE FULL POTENTIAL OF OUR RESOURCES ---PHYSICAL, HUMAN, AND OTHERWISE --- TO BE THE HIGHEST PURPOSE OF GOVERNMENTAL POLICIES NEXT TO THE PROTECTION OF THOSE RIGHTS WE REGARD AS INALIENABLE."

WE HAVE NOT REACHED OUR POTENTIAL TODAY, AND OUR CONSCIENCES ARE TROUBLED IN THE MIDST OF OUR PROSPERITY BY THE KNOWLEDGE THAT MANY AMERICANS HAVE BEEN DEPRIVED OF THEIR BIRTHRIGHT.

WE KNOW THAT THE COLOR OF A MAN'S SKIN OR THE ORIGINS OF HIS FOREFATHERS CAN BLOCK HIM FROM HIS RIGHTS AS A CITIZEN AND THE ACHIEVEMENT OF HIS FULL POTENTIAL AS A HUMAN BEING.

WE KNOW THAT ONE-FIFTH OF OUR POPULATION IS SUFFERING FROM THE DEPRIVATION OF POVERTY.

POVERTY CAN BE TRACED IN THE LIVES OF THOSE WHO HAVE BEEN CUT OFF FROM OPPORTUNITY BY REASON OF THEIR RACE, BECAUSE OF THE



ACCIDENT OF GEOGRAPHY OF THEIR BIRTHPLACE, BECAUSE OF INADEQUATE EDUCATION, BECAUSE OF TECHNOLOGICAL ADVANCES WHICH MADE THEIR JOBS OBSOLETE, BECAUSE OF CHANGES IN THE PRODUCTIVE NEEDS OF THE NATION, OR BECAUSE OF ACCIDENTS OR ILL HEALTH.

THE POOR ARE EXILES IN THEIR OWN COUNTRY. THEY LIVE IN DEFEAT AND PESSIMISM. WITHOUT HELP THEY CANNOT TAKE ADVANTAGE OF NEW OPPORTUNITIES.

I BELIEVE WE CAN MEET THE PROBLEM OF POVERTY. I BELIEVE WE CAN MAKE FREEDOM AND EQUALITY MEANINGFUL BY OFFERING NEW OPPORTUNITIES FOR THE DEPRIVED.

UNTIL EVERY CITIZEN, REGARDLESS OF HIS RACE, CREED OR COLOR, ENJOYS HIS FULL RIGHTS AS A CITIZEN, NONE OF US IS FREE. THE CRUEL BARRIERS OF DISCRIMINATION AND PREJUDICE WILL NOT BE WIPED AWAY IN A SINGLE DAY, BUT THE MAJESTY OF THE LAW AND THE POWER OF THE STATE MUST BE USED TO OVERCOME THESE BARRIERS, NOT TO SUSTAIN THEM.

BUT BEYOND THE ACHIEVEMENT OF EQUALITY IN CITIZENS RIGHTS MUST LIE THE OPPORTUNITY FOR JOES. GUR DREAM IS NOT TO MAKE ALL AMERICANS EQUALLY IMPOVERISHED. OUR GOAL IS TO SWING WIDE THE DOORS OF OPPORTUNITY FOR MEANINGFUL JOES, PAYING DECENT WAGES FOR ALL AMERICANS.

IN THIS CAMPAIGN, I EXPECT TO SEE THE LINES CLEARLY DRAWN BETWEEN THOSE WHO HAVE AN INHERENT DISTRUST OF GOVERNMENT AND THE ABILITY OF THE PEOPLE TO GOVERN THEMSELVES, AND THOSE WHO ARE WILLING TO USE ALL LEVELS OF GOVERNMENT AS INSTRUMENTS OF PUBLIC POLICY IN SOLVING PUBLIC PROBLEMS. THIS IS AN ISSUE FROM WHICH WE NEED NOT SHRINK.

AGAIN AND AGAIN WE NEED TO MAKE OUR POINT: WE ARE BREE MEN AND WOMEN AND WE CAN WORK TOGETHER FOR THE COMMON GOOD. OURS IS A BALANCED SOCIETY IN WHICH INDIVIDUALS, PRIVATE BUSINESS, LABOR, PRIVATE ORGANIZATION, PUBLIC GROUPS, AND THE INSTITUTIONS OF GOVERNM

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CAN WORK TOGETHER, SO LONG AS THERE IS AGREEMENT ON OUR ULTIMATE GOALS AND A RATIONAL DISCUSSION OF THOSE ISSUES WHICH TEND TO DIVIDE US.

IN THIS ELECTION YEAR WE WILL DETERMINE THE LEADERSHIP OF OUR COUNTRY FOR THE NEXT FOUR YEARS. THAT CHOICE WILL NOT BE MADE IN WASHINGTON. IT WILL BE MADE IN THE WARDS AND PRECINCTS OF THE CITIES AND TOWNS, OF THE RURAL AND URBAN AREAS OF NORTH, EAST, SOUTH AND WEST. YOU WILL HELP DETERMINE THAT CHOICE. YOU WILL INFLUENCE THE COURSE OF GOVERNMENT.

INFLUENCING THE VOTE IS MORE THAN A MATTER OF REGISTRATION, ENROLLMENT AND CAREYING VOTERS TO THE POLLS. IT IS A MATTER OF GETTING VOTERS CONCERNED; HELPING THEM TO INFORM THEMSELVES; AND MOTIVATING THEM TO ACT. IF WE MAKE THESE STEPS, THEN WE WILL LIVE UP TO THE FAITH PRESIDENT KENNEDY EXPRESSED IN US:

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"I BELIEVE IN AN AMERICA THAT IS ON THE MARCH ---

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
